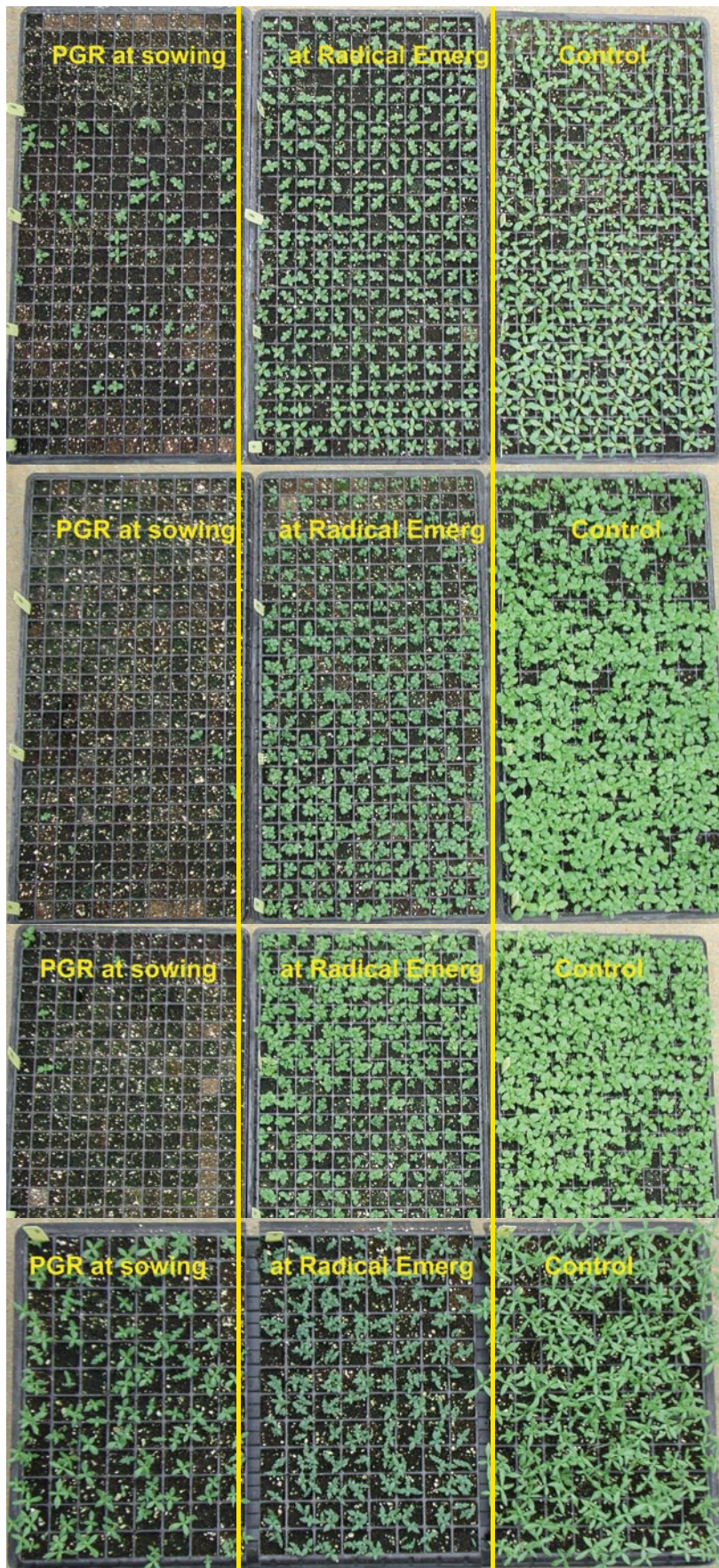

EARLY PGR ALERT

PGR application before or right after sowing could significantly reduce germination rates (far left column) for some varieties such as Angelonia (1), Diascia (2), Nemesia (3) and Linaria (4).

Applying PGR at radical emergence stage (middle column) is recommended for controlling early plug stretch, without severe affects to germination rates.

Right column (Control) had no PGR applications.

For Enchantment Linaria, Bonzi at 2 ppm or A-Rest at 10 ppm should be used at radicle emergence stage to control hypocotyl stretch (top picture). Repeat application with a higher rate (about double rate) 1 week later.

After transplanting, Bonzi spray can strengthen the stems (bottom picture) and make the flower color more intense, especially under warmer conditions. Use a lower rate (about 10 ppm) 1 week after transplant, and then increase rate to 20 to 30 ppm when secondary shoots reach about 1.5 inch (4 cm). Repeat Bonzi spray if necessary.
