<b>Live Wire Isolepis</b>	Low	Green		6 to 8 in./ 15 to 20 cm	306 pack, 4 in./10 cm, 6 in./15 cm*, Gallon	Great for containers, and performs well in ponds and water gardens.
<b>Coolio Koeleria</b>	Low	Green		6 to 8 in./ 15 to 20 cm	4 in./10 cm, 6 in./15 cm*, Gallon	Upright, blue-green grass is ideal for dry locations. Grows to 20 in./50 cm after the first season.
<b>Amazon Mist Carex</b>	Low	Green		6 to 12 in./ 15 to 30 cm	4 in./10 cm, 6 in./15 cm*, Gallon	Variiegated light and medium green grass has twisting tips and an arching habit.

<b>Starhead Juncus</b>	Med.	Green		8 to 10 in./ 20 to 25 cm	4 in./10 cm, 6 in./15 cm*, Gallon	Compact plants produce long-lasting, dark green star inflorescences.
<b>Flashlights Milium</b>	Med.	Green		8 to 16 in./ 20 to 40 cm	306 pack, 4 in./10 cm, 6 in./15 cm*, Gallon	Great lime-green colour and texture for shady spots.
<b>Sirocco Anemanthele</b>	Med.	Green/ Brown		12 to 14 in./ 30 to 35 cm	4 in./10 cm, 6 in./15 cm*, Gallon	Varied shades of copper and pink depending on season/maturity.

<b>Starmaker Luzula</b>	Med.	Green	☀	12 to 18 in./ 30 to 45 cm	4 in./10 cm, 6 in./15 cm*, Gallon	Large, mounded annual grass has broad, glossy leaves, with brown flowers in early Spring.
<b>Festina Festuca</b>	Med.	Green	☀☀	12 to 18 in./ 30 to 45 cm	4 in./10 cm, 6 in./15 cm*, Gallon	Dense, compact, blue-green tufts have small, upright brown plumes from Summer to Autumn. Very cold hardy.
<b>Blue Dart Juncus</b>	Med.	Green	☀☀	14 to 16 in./ 35 to 40 cm	4 in./10 cm, 6 in./15 cm*, Gallon	Blue-green, strong, upright plant.
<b>Pony Tails Stipa</b>	Tall	Green	☀	16 to 24 in./ 40 to 60 cm	4 in./10 cm, 6 in./15 cm*, Gallon	Upright grass has fine, needlelike foliage, with silky green flowers in July that mature to golden blonde.
<b>Phoenix Green Carex</b>	Tall	Green	☀	20 to 24 in./ 50 to 60 cm	4 in./10 cm, 6 in./15 cm*, Gallon	Sturdy, upright and narrow-leaved. Good heat tolerance, easy-care. Use as an accent in landscapes, planters.
<b>Red Rooster Carex</b>	Tall	Red	☀	20 to 30 in./ 50 to 75 cm	4 in./10 cm, 6 in./15 cm*, Gallon	Upright, red-bronze variety has curled tips.
<b>Blue Arrows Juncus</b>	Tall	Green	☀	36 in./ 90 cm	4 in./10 cm, 6 in./15 cm*, Gallon	Blue-green, upright and heat tolerant.
<b>Wind Dancer Eragrostis</b>	Tall	Green	☀	36 to 48 in./ 90 to 120 cm	Gallon	Gracefully shaped, drought-tolerant, Native American grass.
<b>Javelin Juncus</b>	Tall	Green	☀	48 in./ 120 cm	4 in./10 cm, 6 in./15 cm*, Gallon	Rugged, upright plant can grow in standing water, but also handles heat/drought.
