



Lavandula Scheduling Tool from PanAmerican Seed®

General Growing Requirements

Lavender varieties of this presentation are all First Year Flowering; no vernalization is required.

Requirements on climate

- Active growing climate needed.
- Grows best in low humidity.
- Top soil should remain dry between watering.

Requirements on production method

- Annual Spring & Summer Production: Outdoor, or in early season, use a tunnel or a frost-free greenhouse.
- Overwintered Production: Indoor in a frost-free greenhouse; possible outdoor only in the southern regions.

This Scheduling tool is based on using a 288 to a 180-tray plug size and finishing in a 12-13 cm pot.

For this plug range *Lavandula angustifolia* is multi-sown and Bandera is single-sown.

Please note:

Our Scheduling Tool is strictly subject to local climate & environment. The Southern Europe schedule proposal is extrapolated from American trials in different regions. Growers should use the information presented here as a starting point. The commercial crop planning and quality need to be based on grower trials in the respective locations.
