

Daily Watering Checklist: Impatiens

Beacon® Impatiens love well-draining soil. If they're in the ground, be sure to give them water every few days. It is better to keep them on the slightly drier side than too wet. But in hotter temps, increase watering frequency.

For hanging baskets and containers, monitor them for water daily. Be careful not to overwater them. Impatiens do not like water-logged roots.

Test the soil using the tilting method for your containers. After watering, tilt the pot to feel how heavy it is. Likewise, when the pot is dry, tilt it to learn what a fully dry container feels like.

Beacon Impatiens are light feeders, so they don't need a lot nor very frequent fertilizing!

When Impatiens are grown with lower amounts of fertilizer, the plants will flower more. Happy plants make for happy gardeners.
