







Taishan Marigold is a facultative short-day plant. The plants flower earlier when grown with a daylength of less than 14 hours. A daylength of 14 hours or more will delay flowering about 2 weeks.

Culture Research





The peduncles of Taishan are about 20% shorter and 15% thicker than Antigua (top photo), which makes Taishan a tougher plant. This benefit reduces flower stem breakage during production and shipping (bottom photo), providing more saleable plants.
