Culture information for Autumn production.

CULTURE INFORMATION

- Sow mid- May, using 288 trays and 1 seed per cell
- Transplant mid June to 8x5" Mum pots 1 3 ppp depending on vigor
- Move to outdoor finish mid July
- Use constant feed 300ppm N, similar to Mum Program feed
- Transplant to finish times 11-13 weeks, depending on variety

- No plug PGRs are needed, stretched plugs can be planted deep.



UNICONAZOLE APPLICATION

- Uniconazole is now labeled for use on ornamental peppers
- Restrictions apply:
 - Maximum total allowed application not to exceed 10 ppm at 2 qts per 1000 sq ft
 - Last spray must be no later than 2 weeks after the 2-4 leaf stage, about 4-6 weeks after sowing.
- Our recommendations are 1x uniconazole at 2.5ppm spray in plug, at 2 weeks after sowing or (depending on vigor of variety)
- 2x uniconazole at 2.5ppm spray in plug, at 2 and 4 weeks after sowing
