

## Lavandula Spanish Eyes

(*Lavandula multifida*)

Perennials Culture (revised 02/20/18)

**Plug crop time:** 5 to 6 weeks

**Transplant to finish:** 10 to 12 weeks

- Fast-growing tender perennial/annual variety flowers all Summer, right up until frost.
- Soft-textured and finely cut fernleaf foliage is topped by branched, 4-in./10-cm spikes that are beautiful in bud and stunning when blooms open.
- Free-flowering in pot and garden.

### Common Problems

Relatively problem-free, except is more vigorous and needs more PGR than *L. angustifolia*.

### Finishing Key Tips

Grow relatively dry and provide active climate. Vigorous *Lavandula* needs more PGRs than *L. angustifolia* and *L. stoechas*, and is a long-flowering annual.
