Fertilizer Notation

Use a balanced ammonium and nitrate-based fertilizer with low phosphorus.

Finishing Key Tips

Juvenility ends at 6 leaves; at that point, growing under 14 hours for 4 weeks induces plants to flower. See GrowerFacts for detailed PGR program and LIP recommendations.
