

Thymophylla Golden Dawn

(*Thymophylla tenuiloba*)

Annuals Culture (revised 03/14/17)

Plug crop time: 5 weeks

Transplant to finish: 9 to 12 weeks

- Long-flowering, spreading plant is covered with daisylike, golden yellow flowers on fine, ferny foliage.
- Heat and humidity-lover is an excellent performer in hanging baskets, patio planters and garden beds.

Propagation Key Tips

Pre-cool 1 week at 50°F (10°C), then 64-68°F (18 to 20°C). Lowering temperature after germination results in more compact seedlings.
