(*Talinum paniculatum*)

Annuals Culture (revised 08/29/19)

Plug crop time: 5 weeks

Transplant to finish: Foliage 4 to 5 weeks; add 2 weeks to flower

- Dark green-leafed companion to Limón has small flowers that open hot pink and then form orange berries that ripen to dark red.
- Flexible flower spikes make it easy to grow and ship.
- Durable accent plant handles heat and stress well, including both low water and soggy conditions.
- Excellent for mixed containers; also a long-lasting landscape option.

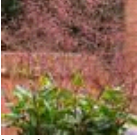

Finishing Key Tips

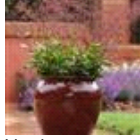
For flowers, add 2 weeks to Finish Crop Time.
