

## Cucumber Patio Snacker F<sub>1</sub>

(*Cucumis sativus*)

Vegetables Culture (revised 02/25/20)

- Controlled yet vigorous variety produces short, branching vines.
- Fruit has good flavour, crunchy texture and non-bitter peel.
- High-yielding with continuous harvest.
- Great for large containers with a small trellis; works well in pack/pot programs.

### Propagation Key Tips

Best performance when directly sown into final container. Height can be controlled by withholding fertilizer, avoiding overwatering, growing under high light conditions and using DIF when possible.

## Finishing Key Tips

Direct-sow into final container. Performs well in-ground and in containers. Vining plants can be trained up a trellis to save garden space.
