Fertiliser Notation

Use a nitrate-based fertilizer with low phosphorus; avoid using excessive ammonia, nitrogen-based fertilizer and overfeeding, as these will result in less upright plants.

Common Problems

Insects: Aphids, especially after Winter regrowth Too high feed and watering, results in floppy plants

Finishing Key Tips

Grow relatively dry and with low to moderate fertilization, to have optimal upright growth.
